## The Markan Challenge: Let's read the Gospel of Mark together!

During this coming year, our Gospel readings will highlight the Gospel according to Mark. You can easily read through the Gospel of Mark in less than two hours...and we would recommend that you carve out time to read it through in one sitting. But to really hear the story of Jesus through Mark's telling, slowly and attentively reading all of the gospel over several weeks can greatly benefit your spiritual life.

All of St. David's is invited and encouraged to join in reading through the Gospel according to Mark during the Epiphany season.

We, as a parish, will divide the book into small amounts of reading each week, and we will talk about what we have read and highlight important passages from Mark's narrative during Adult Faith Formation on Sunday mornings.

We hope you will join in making time for this communal reading of Scripture, and we encourage you to come for Adult Formation classes for a deeper understanding of this Gospel.
